PreRequisites:

- Read pp 136-144 Systematic Software Testing (Included in Workbook)
- Read pp 19-29 xUnit Test Patterns (Included in Workbook)
- Make a github account so you can review and fork repositories that are interesting to you
- Download pycharm, vscode, or another code editor so you can look at code on your local machine, and make notes (if you would like)

FAQ:

- o Do I have to do the reading ahead of the workshop?
 - Yes, it is important to do the reading at least the day before the workshop. The reading is foundation knowledge about unit testing theory and practice. I recommend getting access to both books as references to use during your discussions with developers and managers.
- o Do I have to know how to write code to take this workshop?
 - No. We will look at examples from different languages and repositories on github. If you are new to reading code or navigating code directories, then you may wish to follow the checklist in the Session Workbook.
